NOTICE UNDER SECTION 42 OF THE *ELECTORAL ACT 1992*

INVITATION FOR WRITTEN SUGGESTIONS

The *Electoral Act 1992* (the Act) requires the Queensland Redistribution Commission to redistribute the State into 93 electoral districts.

Under section 42 of the Act, the Commission invites all interested persons and bodies to lodge their suggestions **on or before 5pm Monday, 25 July 2016**.

Suggestions can be lodged for a period of 30 days and will be published as soon as possible after submissions close. Submissions may be viewed at the Commission's office and on the website.

Based on May 2016 statistics, the **average number of enrolled electors** for 93 districts is: 33,065.

In preparing its proposal, section 45 of the Act requires the Commission to ensure the following:

- (a) if the electoral district has an area of less than 100,000km² – the number of enrolled electors does not differ from the average number of enrolled electors per district by more than 10%; and
- (b) if the electoral district has an area of 100,000km² or more – the sum of the number of enrolled electors and the *additional large district number* does not differ from the average by more than 10%.

Additional large district number means 2% of the number of km² in the area of the electoral district.

The Commission would prefer electronic submissions that are accompanied by maps. If you lodge a suggestion, please note that all **submissions will be published in their entirety**, including name and address details.
