Queensland Redistribution Commission invites suggestions

The Queensland Redistribution Commission invites suggestions on the redistribution of the State into 93 electoral districts for a period of 30 days, from Saturday, 25 June 2016 to Monday, 25 July 2016.

The Commission will advertise the notice inviting submissions in the Queensland Government Gazette on Friday, 24 June 2016 as prescribed by section 42 of the *Electoral Act 1992*.

The advertisement will run in 46 newspapers circulating throughout Queensland, including the Courier and Sunday Mail and various other papers. These advertisements will appear from Saturday, 25 June 2016 (the day submissions formally open) through to the following Friday, 1 July 2016.

Based on May 2016 enrolment data, the average number of enrolled electors for 93 districts is: 33,065. As there are currently 89 electoral districts, submitters should factor the need to create an additional four districts into their suggestions and are encouraged to use the electoral enrolment data provided online.

Submissions will be accepted through online form, personal delivery and through the post.
